## Day 2-Person Best Ball by Dooley.Com Tour May 31, 2010

### Rules of Play

**Format:** 18-hole two-person best ball played at 90% of each player's handicap. The low gross scores and net scores for the 18 holes will be declared the overall winner. Gross and net divisions with separate payouts. Golfers will be eligible for payouts in only 1 division (the higher of the two amounts). Trophies awarded for the net division champions. Optional skins game \$5.00 gross and \$5.00 net per person.

**Late Start Rule:** A team failing to appear on the first tee at their designated time will be assessed a two-stroke penalty. A team failing to appear on the first tee after five minutes of their designated time will be disqualified.

### Rules of Play:

- All USGA Rules Apply
- Men play all tee shots from the white tees.
- Women play all tee shots from the red tees.
- The 14-club rule is in effect
- The one ball rule is in effect

**Out of Bounds:** Marked by property fence, white stakes and/or white lines.

In course out of bounds on the right side of hole #6 and the left side of hole #18.

Red stakes and lines mark all lateral water hazards.

Yellow stakes and lines mark all regular water hazards.

There is no relief from wood chips around trees. Staked trees permit relief.

Free drop from naturalized areas one club length no closer to the hole.

### **Rule 6-7. Undue Delay; slow play**

The player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines, which may be laid down by the committee. Between completion of a hole and playing from the next tee ground, the player shall not unduly delay play.

**Note 2:** For the purpose of preventing slow play, the committee may, in the conditions of competition (rule 33-1), lay down pace of play guidelines including maximum periods of time allowed to complete a stipulated round, a hole or a stroke. In stroke play only, the committee may, in such condition, modify the penalty for breach of this rule follows.

**First offense – Verbal Warning**  
**Second offense – One stroke penalty**  
**Third offense – Disqualification**

Each group will be required to complete there round of golf in 4 hours and 15 minutes.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the low finishers in Gross and Net Divisions. Prizes are awarded in the form of cash.
